- Identify appropriate needs assessment methodologies and data collection tools, according to the context and the evaluation of terms of reference
- Describe the main steps in the design of multi-sectoral programmes and projects
- Design and use the Logical Framework based on the Logical Framework Analysis
- Design a monitoring and evaluation framework for the project, selecting the appropriate tools and indicators
- Choose relevant criteria in order to develop objectives for an ex-post evaluation (end of project evaluation)

PROGRAMME

- Day 1: introduction to project cycle management and diagnostics
- Day 2: project design and planning
- Day 3: implementation, closure and evaluation

Step 1: application
