- Ensure the security and availability of funds during a mission (cash management)
- Use tools and methods to ensure budgetary control and management of activities

- You work in project management or logistics and need to deepen your understanding of the financial management tools used in humanitarian projects.
- You work in the humanitarian sector and wish to develop a career in administration and finance.

- **Week 4** Budget management: preparation of a financial report and links to the principles of budgetary control and financial audit
