More specifically, you will learn:

- Define culture and intercultural competences.
- Identify the intercultural competences required in the workplace and in interpersonal relationships.
- Distinguishing the challenges associated with a multicultural workplace – Assessing the elements of one's own culture and worldview.
- Examine the factors that influence intercultural conflicts.
- Bring the team together around a shared understanding of intercultural issues and develop an action plan to promote and maintain diversity and inclusion.
- Select appropriate oral and written communication strategies for a multicultural context.

PROFILE

This training is aimed at professionals working in international, multicultural or intercultural environments who wish to strengthen their ability to work effectively with people from diverse cultural backgrounds.

It is particularly relevant for team leaders, managers, project coordinators and professionals working in international organizations, NGOs and humanitarian settings, as well as anyone involved in multicultural teams or professional relationships.
