- You aspire to join the international solidarity sector and wish to strengthen your team management skills in the humanitarian field.

TRAINING COURSE PROGRAMME

Week 1: The role of the manager and management methods and techniques: positive and effective communication, motivation processes, situational management

Week 2: Recruitment and team organization: recruitment processes, drafting job descriptions, drawing up different types of organization charts

Week 3: Team leadership and management by objectives: meetings, setting objectives and providing support, skills assessment

Week 4: Managing difficult situations (including conflict management)
